Πανεπιστημιακοί και ερευνητές από 26 χώρες του εξωτερικού ζητούν την άμεση παύση της συνδικαλιστικής δίωξης του Προέδρου και των μελών του ΔΣ του ΕΣΔΕΠ ΑΠΘ

Ο ΕΣΔΕΠ ΑΠΘ δίνει στη δημοσιότητα τα ονόματα διακοσίων (200) Πανεπιστημιακών και Ερευνητριών/τών από πανεπιστήμια 26 χωρών της Ευρώπης, της Αμερικής και της Αυστραλίας, οι οποίες/οί εκφράζουν την αλληλεγγύη τους στον Πρόεδρο και τα μέλη του ΔΣ του ΕΣΔΕΠ ΑΠΘ, που αντιμετωπίζουν σοβαρές ποινικές κατηγορίες εξαιτίας της συμμετοχής τους σε κινητοποίηση και της δημόσιας στήριξής τους στα δίκαια αιτήματα των εστιακών φοιτητριών/των του ΑΠΘ.

Όπως σημειώνουν οι Πανεπιστημιακοί και ερευνητές από τα πανεπιστήμια του εξωτερικού η συνδικαλιστική δίωξη των μελών του ΕΣΔΕΠ ΑΠΘ είναι η πρώτη απόπειρα δίωξης μελών ΔΕΠ στην Ελλάδα κατ' εφαρμογή του νέου σχετικού πειθαρχικού πλαισίου που ψήφισε η ελληνική κυβέρνηση το προηγούμενο καλοκαίρι. Επίσης σημειώνουν ότι η δίωξη αυτή μελών ΔΕΠ δεν είναι η μόνη σε πανεπιστήμια της Ευρώπης καθώς δεκάδες μέλη ΔΕΠ έχουν υποστεί πειθαρχικές διώξεις ή έχουν απολυθεί εξαιτίας της δημόσιας αντίθεσης τους στη γενοκτονία στη Γάζα, στην εμπορευματοποίηση της ανώτατης εκπαίδευσης ή εξαιτίας της άρνησης συμμετοχής τους σε στρατιωτικά ερευνητικά προγράμματα, εκφράζοντας παράλληλα την έντονη ανησυχία τους για αυτές τις αντιδημοκρατικές πρακτικές στα πανεπιστήμια, οι οποίες περιορίζουν τις ακαδημαϊκές ελευθερίες έκφρασης και κοινωνικής δράσης.

Οι 200 πανεπιστημιακοί και ερευνητές από πανεπιστήμια του εξωτερικού καταλήγουν **ζητώντας την άμεση παύση οποιαδήποτε δίωξης εις βάρος των συναδέλφων τους στο ΑΠΘ.**

Σημειώνεται ότι οι αντιδράσεις αυτές της διεθνούς επιστημονικής κοινότητας έρχονται να προστεθούν στις γενικευμένες [αντιδράσεις της πανεπιστημιακής κοινότητας στην Ελλάδα](#), όπου 20 σύλλογοι μελών ΔΕΠ από 15 πανεπιστήμια της χώρας, η Πανελλήνια Ομοσπονδία Συλλόγων ΔΕΠ (ΠΟΣΔΕΠ), η Ομοσπονδία Διοικητικού Προσωπικού στη Τριτοβάθμια Εκπαίδευση (ΟΔΠΤΕ) και η Πανελλήνια Ομοσπονδία Συλλόγων Ειδικού Εργαστηριακού Διδακτικού Προσωπικού (ΠΟΣΕΕΔΠ), έχουν με ψηφίσματα τους καταδικάσει την απόπειρα δίωξης των μελών του ΔΣ του ΕΣΔΕΠ ΑΠΘ, ζητώντας και αυτοί με τη σειρά τους την αρχειοθέτηση των αβάσιμων κατηγοριών εναντίον τους.

Signatories in support of AUTH Faculty Union members prosecuted

We, the signatories, **condemn the legal harassment and possible prosecution of the President of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (AUTH) Faculty Union — Associate Professor Elias Kondilis** (acting also President of the International Association of Health Policy and member of the People's Health Movement), **and two members of the Union's Board, Prof Dimitris Raptakis and Prof Sotiris Sotiropoulos**, on very serious legal charges.

The three academics and unionists are being prosecuted for participating in a recent Student Union demonstration against the new regulatory framework governing the AUTH dormitories. It is worth noting that university dormitories in Greece are still public and free of charge, hosting the most financially vulnerable students on campus. The new regulatory framework severely restricts students' rights and shifts repairing costs onto these already financially constrained students. The three faculty unionists participated in the demonstration in solidarity with the dormitory students' struggle.

The prosecution of the President and Board members of the AUTH Faculty Union ([ΕΣΔΕΠ ΑΠΘ](#)) is the first case in Greece involving academics prosecuted under the new disciplinary legal framework passed by the Greek Government last summer. This framework introduces stricter disciplinary measures and penalizes acts of support by faculty members for student collective actions that may be perceived by university authorities as “disruptive”.

The case of the three academics under prosecution in Greece is not unique in Europe. Many academics in higher education are being prosecuted or losing their jobs for expressing opposition to the genocide in Gaza, criticizing the commercialization of higher education, or refusing to participate in military research projects within their institutions.

The shift towards a war economy in Europe, the increasing geopolitical tensions and conflicts, and the subsequent militarization of higher education and research are pushing universities towards stricter disciplinary regulations for faculty members, restricting academic freedom of speech and academics' freedom of social action.

We express our deep concern regarding these anti-democratic trends.

We also express our solidarity with the three prosecuted Greek academics and demand the immediate cessation of all legal action against them.
